Participants will walk away with practical strategies they can immediately apply in their classrooms to support academic success and promote equitable instruction for all learners.

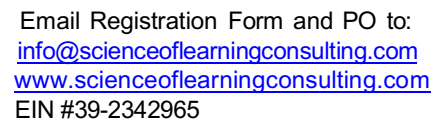
