- Assist CALP academic comprehension in L2 by practicing academic skills taught in L2
- Assist CALP academic comprehension in L1 by practicing academic skills learned
- Enhances academic and linguistic "rigor"

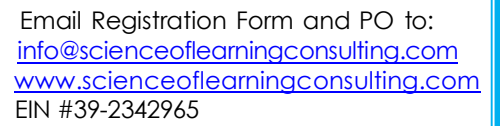
